AC	Assistant Commissioner - As a member of the Metropolitan Police Service Management Board, they have responsibility for leading the Service, creating a vision and setting direction and culture for the Service that builds public and organisational confidence and trust and enables the delivery of a professional, effective and efficient policing service. For more information, click here.
ACC	Assistant Chief Constable - Responsible for contributing to the creation of the vision and setting direction and culture for Forces as part of the Chief Officer Team that builds public and organisational confidence and trust, and enables the delivery of an effective policing service. For more information, click here.
AAFDA	Advocacy After Fatal Domestic Abuse - A centre of excellence that provides specialist and expert advocacy and specialist peer support to families and friends bereaved by domestic homicide, domestic abuse related suicides and unexplained deaths. For more information, click here.
AFH	Adult Family Homicide - Homicide of an individual aged 18 or over by an adult family member who is not an intimate partner.
BCU	Basic Command Unit - The largest unit into which territorial British Police forces are divided. They may alternatively be called an Area Command, a Division, a Local Policing Unit (LPU) or a Local Policing Team (LPT).
CC	Chief Constable - They have overall responsibility for leading a Force, creating a vision and setting direction and culture that builds public and organisational confidence and trust, and enables the delivery of a professional, effective and efficient policing service. For more information, click here.
ССВ	Coercive Controlling Behaviour - This can involve a pattern of abuse behaviour including threats, intimidation, degradation, isolation from family and friends, emotional and financial or economic abuse, jealousy, microregulation, monitoring and surveillance. This pattern of coercion and control can then be (re)enforced by physical and sexual violence. For more information, click here.

CID	Criminal Investigation Department - The department that investigates crimes of a more serious nature, which may require specialist skills to ensure more complex or serious crimes are investigated fully. The types of serious crimes that they investigate are murders, serious assaults, robberies, fraud, and sexual offences.
CPD	Career Professional Development
CPS	Crown Prosecution Service - The independent service that prosecutes criminal cases that have been investigated by the police and other investigative organisations in England and Wales. For more information, click here.
CSI	Crime Scene Investigation - Forensic services employed by the police to enable appropriate processing of a wide range of crime scenes. For more information, click here.
DAPPA	Domestic Abuse Partnership Perpetrator Approach - A multi-agency approach (involving police and key partners) to addressing domestic abuse, managing perpetrators of domestic abuse and protecting vulnerable victims. For more information, click here.
DHR	Domestic Homicide Review - A multi-agency review of the circumstances in which the death of a person aged 16 or over has, or appears to have, resulted from violence, abuse or neglect. For more information, click here.
DI	Detective Inspector - A police officer who investigates crime and who ranks above a detective sergeant but below a detective chief inspector.
DRIVE	A programme aimed at disrupting patterns of abuse from domestic abuse perpetrators who pose a serious risk of harm to those they are in relationships with. For more information, click here.
DVDS	Domestic Violence Disclosure Scheme (Clare's Law) - Enables the police to disclose information to a victim or potential victim of domestic abuse about their partner's or ex-partner's previous abusive or violent offending. For more information, click here.
IDVA	Independent Domestic Violence Advisor - A trained specialist who provides a service to victims at high risk of harm from intimate partners, ex-partners, or family members, with the aim of securing their, and their children's, safety. For more information, click here.
IOM	Integrated Offender Management - Brings a cross-agency response to the crime and reoffending threats faced by local communities. The most persistent and problematic offenders are identified and managed jointly by partner agencies working together. For more information, click here.
IPH	Intimate Partner Homicide - Homicide of an adult aged 18 or over by a current or former intimate partner.
LGBTQ+	Lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer/questioning and many other terms (such as non-binary and pansexual)

MAPPA	Multi-agency Public Protection Arrangements - A set of arrangements which provides a common framework for the identification, assessment and management of certain offenders in communities. For more information, click here.
MASH	Multi-Agency Safeguarding Hub - A single point of access to the services that help keep vulnerable people safe. These services include social care; police; health services; mental health services; early help; housing; probation; substance misuse and victim support services. For more information, click here.
MATAC	Multi-Agency Task and Coordination - A process for identifying and tackling serial perpetrators of domestic abuse perpetrators. For more information, click here.
MARAC	Multi-Agency Risk Assessment Conference - A meeting where information is shared on the highest risk domestic abuse cases between representatives of local police, health, child protection, housing practitioners, IDVAs, probation and other specialists from the statutory and voluntary sectors. MDAP	Management of Domestic Abuse Perpetrators
MODUS	A case management system for domestic abuse agencies to enable them to record, monitor and process client records.
MORILE	Management of Risk in Law Enforcement - A national project of risk prioritisation models and processes that all UK law enforcement agencies can use to better understand their risks. For more information, click here.
Niche	A police records management system for large agencies, multi-agency systems and data sharing.
NPCC	National Police Chief's Council - The national coordination body for law enforcement in the United Kingdom and the representative body for British police chief officers. For more information, click here.
OBE	Officer of the British Emperor – A distinguished regional or county-wide role in any field, through achievement or service to the community including notable practitioners known nationally.
PDP	Potentially Dangerous Person - a person who is not currently managed under one of the three MAPPA categories, but reasonable grounds exist for believing that there is a risk of them committing an offence or offences that will cause serious harm. For more information, click here.
PIP 2	The PIP 2 Investigator utilises a range of appropriate investigative approaches to gather material, placing the victim at the centre of all actions and decisions, to safely and effectively investigate serious and complex crimes with a view to achieving an appropriate outcome for that investigation. For more information, click here.
PIP 3 SIO	The Senior Investigating Officer has undertaken a module to further develop the knowledge and skills gained during professionalising investigation programme (PIP 2). The Senior Investigator leads as the Senior Investigative Officer on specified crime investigations. They are accountable to chief officers for the conduct of the investigation. For more information, click here.

PIP 4 SIO	The Strategic Investigating Officer (PIP 4) provides independent advice, support and review for high profile, complex, serious and organised or major crime investigations. For more information, click here.
PNC	Police National Computer - a database used by law enforcement organisations across the United Kingdom and other non-law enforcement agencies.
Problem Profile	A commissioned analysis used to understand crime trends and high-risk problems. It assists in prioritising issues, identifying subjects, and applying analytical methods. The profile provides detailed information, analysis, and recommendations for prevention, intelligence, enforcement, and reassurance efforts. It also assesses risks and suggests actions to minimise their impact. For a more information, click here.
PVP	Protecting vulnerable people - A common term used by the police and other safeguarding agencies in relation to concerns for the welfare of a child or other vulnerable person. PVP information is recorded on police systems and shared with partner organisations.
QPM	Queen's Police Medal - awarded to police in the United Kingdom for gallantry or a specially distinguished record in police specific services of conspicuous merit.
RFG matrix	Recency Frequency and Gravity matrix - a risk matrix used to identify problematic perpetrators of domestic abuse. In some force areas, an alternative term for this is the Recency Frequency Harm (RFH) score.
SAR	Safeguarding Adults Review - a multi-agency review which seeks to determine what agencies and individuals could have worked differently, to prevent abuse, neglect or a death from taking place. For more information, click here.
STORM	System for Tasking and Operational Resource Management - A computer system used by the force to create and manage incidents reported by members of the public but also to manage the deployment of operational resources.
THRIVE	Threat, harm, risk, investigation, vulnerability and engagement (THRIVE) model: A model used to assess the right initial police response to a call for service. It allows a judgement to be made of the relative risk posed by the call and places the individual needs of the victim at the centre of that decision. For more information, click here.
VAF	Vulnerability Assessment Framework - a tool to prompt identifying vulnerability in all circumstances where the police have contact with victims, suspects and witnesses. For more information, click here.
